

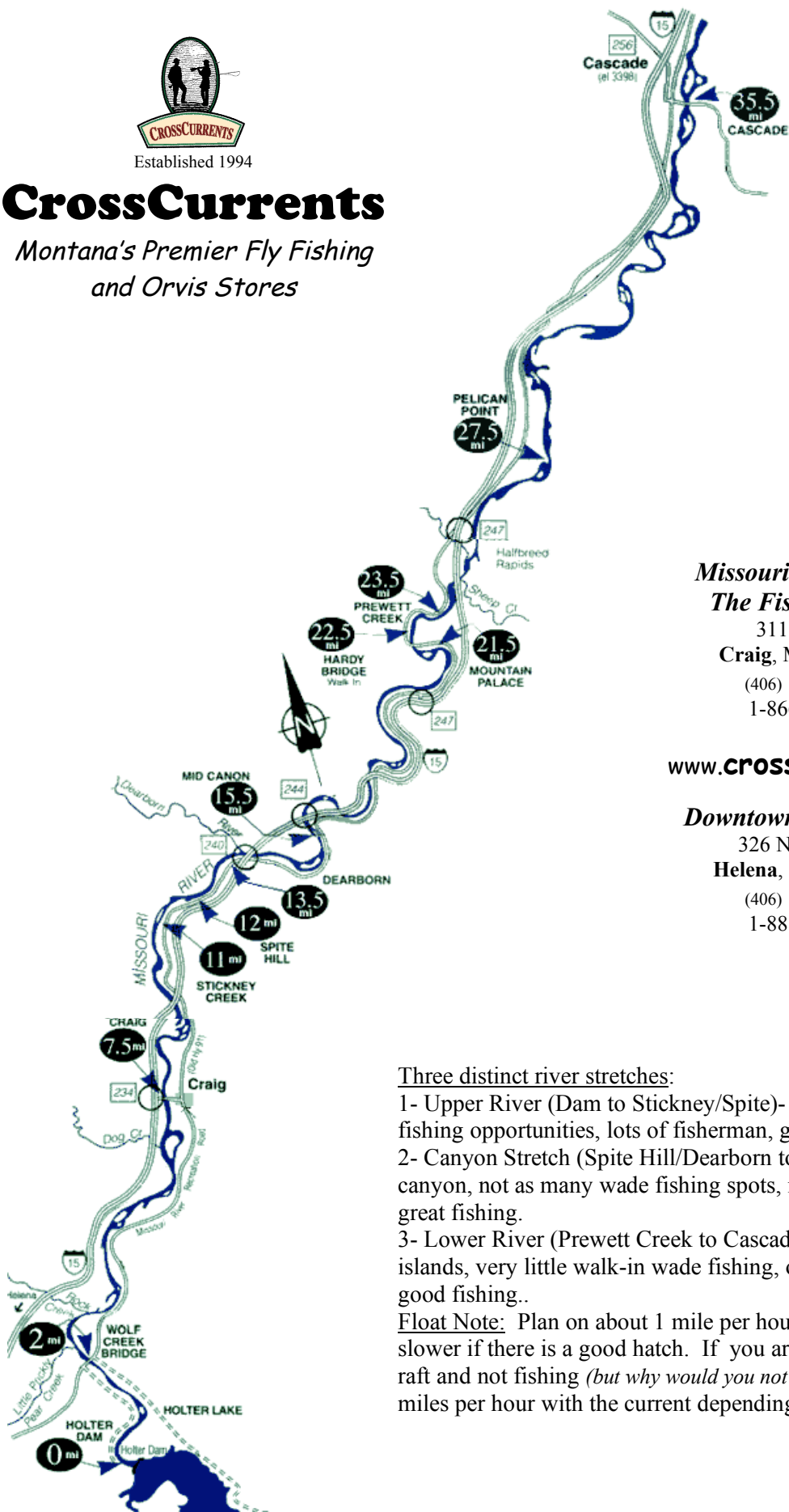

### Three distinct river stretches:

- 1- Upper River (Dam to Stickney/Spite)- Lots of fish, lots of wade fishing opportunities, lots of fisherman, great fishing.
- 2- Canyon Stretch (Spite Hill/Dearborn to Prewett Creek)- beautiful canyon, not as many wade fishing spots, more houses/private land, still great fishing.
- 3- Lower River (Prewett Creek to Cascade)- lower gradient, lots of islands, very little walk-in wade fishing, open prairie/ranch land, still good fishing..

Float Note: Plan on about 1 mile per hour when fishing; often times slower if there is a good hatch. If you are just floating in a drift boat or raft and not fishing (*but why would you not fish?!*) you will travel about 2-4 miles per hour with the current depending on the dam release flow.
